



Navarre Beach Marine Science Station Chaperone Responsibilities

The following list identifies your responsibilities as a chaperone when accompanying students on a Navarre Beach Marine Science Station field trip. Please review the list, sign and return to your child's teacher by _____ if you are interested in being a chaperone.

EACH SCHOOL GROUP kayaking / field studies must have TWO chaperones in the water to monitor water activities. In addition to chaperones in the water, NBMSS high school students will also assist with water activities. CHECK HERE _____ if you volunteer to get a little wet and have some fun!

Additional requirements for chaperones:

- Must be 21 years old or a parent of a student going on this field trip. A ratio of 1 chaperone per 10 students is recommended.
- No children except for those in the participating class or group may attend this field trip.
- Provide close supervision of small groups (no more than 10 students).
- A schedule will be provided to you upon arrival
- Follow assigned agenda of activities. Please refrain from cell phone use.
- No tobacco or alcoholic beverages are permitted on field trips.
- NO SWIMMING IS ALLOWED** on any field trip. Students will be in the water for kayaking.
- IMMEDIATELY** report **ANY PROBLEMS** directly to the teacher.
- Arrive 15 minutes prior to departure time of the trip.
